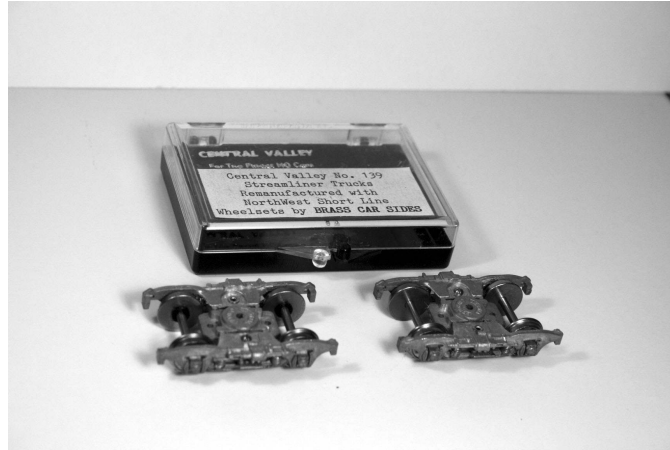


Central Valley T-139 HO 4-wheel Streamlined Passenger Car Trucks



Central Valley trucks were the "Cadillacs" of HO trucks for over two decades, but the final production runs in the early 1980's suffered from inferior wheelsets and fabrication. We acquired 155 pairs new from Franciscan Hobbies in 1986 and then rebuilt them, both for sale to our mailorder customers and for our private collection. The rebuilding involved replacing the wheelsets with new Northwest Short Line wheelsets and removing the rivets on one side and replacing them with new brass screws and nuts. The side frames were straightened and aligned. The original black foam packing was removed and the trucks chemically cleaned, after which Labelle 107 oil was lightly applied at the axle needle points. We are making the remaining pairs available for sale at a price of \$15.00 for one pair, or \$14.00 for multiple pairs. Shipping cost is \$5.00 for the first pair and an additional \$0.75 per pair above that. Insurance additional if desired. As of August 1, 2009 we had 28 pairs left for sale.
