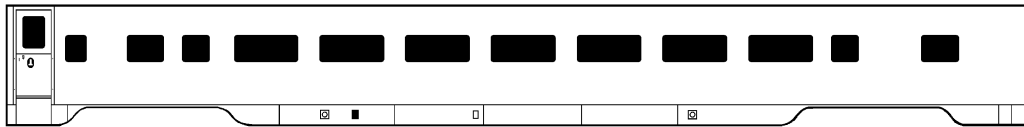

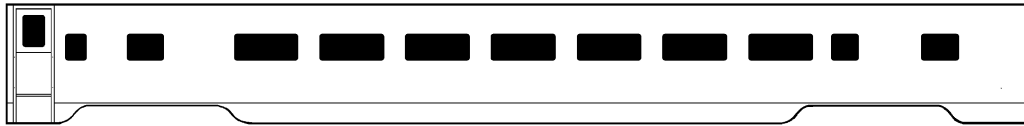

Announcement of New Products

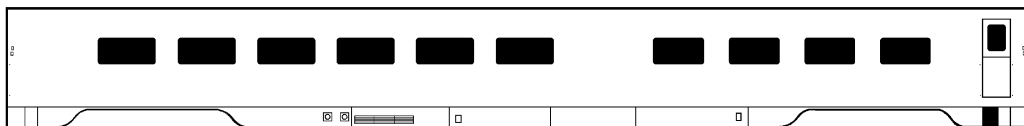
Brass Car Sides is pleased to announce the release in early December of the following HO and N-scale photoetched brass car sides for Great Northern post-war streamliners.



- #173-74 GN/CB&Q 1110-14 60-seat coach HO sides for '47 *Empire Builder* and *Western Star* \$33.75
#173-574 GN/CB&Q 1110-14 60-seat coach N sides for '47 *Empire Builder* and *Western Star* \$23.75



- #173-76 GN 1116-series ACF 60-seat no-office coach HO sides for *Internationals* & *Red River* \$33.75
#173-576 GN 1116-series ACF 60-seat no-office coach N sides for *Internationals* & *Red River* \$23.75



- #173-75 GN/CB&Q 1150-1155 dining car HO sides for '47 *Empire Builder* and *Western Star* \$33.75
#173-575 GN/CB&Q 1150-1155 dining car N sides for '47 *Empire Builder* and *Western Star* \$23.75

The first five of these dining cars were built by P-S in 1946 to Plan 7498 in Lot 6718 and the sixth in 1949 as an empty shell finished by the GN. When the *Empire Builder* was re-equipped in 1951 these cars were assigned to the *Western Star*. They were owned, named and numbered as follows: GN 1150 "Lake Superior", GN 1151 "Lake McDonald", GN 1152 "Lake Chelan", GN 1153 "Lake Josephine", CB&Q 1154 "Lake Michigan" (to GN in 1955), GN 1155 "Lake Washington".

The brass sides include the original full skirting with etched line details and grabiron holes. The center skirts may be removed to model the cars in their later appearance. The HO sides are sized to serve as overlays on specific Walthers *Empire Builder* cars. They may also be easily used with our #173-101 Basic Body Kit. The N-scale sides are designed to be used with the American Ltd. Models Core Kits.
